TOWN OF COWPENS SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING 5330 N. Main St. January 11, 2022

The Town of Cowpens held a special meeting on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Michael D. Hamrick, Council Members Pam Camp, Thomas Voelker, and Erin P. Wofford. Absent: Mayor Pro-Tem Jarred S. Spencer. Mayor Hamrick called the meeting to order, and Erin Wofford held prayer.

Steve Bolin reviewed with Town Council the Overview of the Final Rule, for the ARAP Funds, from the U.S. Department of Treasury. - 1. Government Services (to include leaf vac & limb chipper)

- 3. Parking Lot Upgrades (Foster St. with lights, lines, grading)
- 4. Premium Pay for Essential Workers
- 5. Consulting Fees
- 6. Paving Roads
- 7. Broadband/Wifi

Other topics previously discussed could be done with grants or other funding and are listed as follows:

- 1. Highway 110 (other grants are possible)
- 2. Bunch Circle Sewer Project (gravity issue)
- 3. Waters Road Sidewalk Project (C Funds are a possible funding source)

Steve Bolin made a list of estimated cost for some of the projects and will submit it to town council through email.

Thomas Voelker made a motion to adjourn, second by Erin P. Wofford and carried.
