- b) Depot repairs include painting, decking, and a new roof.

- d) Farmers' Market HVAC, insulation, floors, paint, improve plumbing, fix drainage issues, and roof.

Fire Chief Blanton has included a change of pay rates in his budget and a request to bring the pay in line with other agencies in the area. Pam Camp made a motion to approve the rate changes for the fire department, seconded by Erin Wofford, and carried.
