Town of Cowpens Regular Council Meeting May 16, 2016

The Town of Cowpens held a regular meeting on Monday, May 16, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. A budget workshop was conducted at 6:00 p.m. Present were, Mayor Michael D. Hamrick, Mayor Pro-Tem Brenda J. Adair Council Members Bobby Dowis, Roy Logan and Jarred S. Spencer.

Police Department

Officers issued 25 citations and 25 warnings. Six of these citations were for speeding. Total fines collected \$2,804.00 and the town's portion was \$1,310.62. A total of 8,054 miles were accumulated on all vehicles.

Fire Department

Steve Bolin reported that the fire department had 34 fire calls during the month of April. Ten calls were in the town, ten calls in the fire district, nine in Spartanburg County, and five in Cherokee County. A total of 1,630 miles were accumulated on seven vehicles.

Street Department
