

**TOWN OF COWPENS
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
June 18, 2018**

The Town of Cowpens held its regular council meeting on Monday, June 18, 2018, at 5:30 p.m. Present were Mayor Michael D. Hamrick, Mayor Pro-Tem Brenda J. Adair, Council Members Roy Logan, and Jarred S. Spencer, and Thomas Voelker.

A public hearing was conducted to provide information to the public for the 2018-2019 fiscal year budgets.

Pam Camp thanked town council and commended all employees for their hard work and effort to make this year's Mighty Moo Festival a huge success.

Mayor Hamrick called the meeting to order and Brenda J. Adair held prayer and included a moment of silence for the families of area residents who had lost loved ones and those who have sickness in their families.

Approval of Agenda

Jarred S. Spencer made a motion approve the agenda for June 18, 2018, second by Roy Logan and carried.

Approval of Minutes & Financial Statements

Council discussed the minutes of May 21, 2018. Roy Logan made a motion to approve the minutes, second by Brenda J. Adair and carried.

Brenda J. Adair made a motion to approve the purchase journals, account registers, and monthly bank statements, second by Jarred S. Spencer and carried.

Department Reports

The police department issued 39 citations during the month of May 2018 and 54 warnings. Fines collected totaled \$5,389.00. The town's portion was \$2,252.49.

Steve Bolin reported the number of fire calls for the fire department, as well as mileage for each department. The fire department answered 13 calls for the month of May 2018. Two calls were in the Town, eight calls in the fire district, two calls were mutual aid in Spartanburg County, and one call in Cherokee County.

Old Business –

A. Second Reading of the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget

Jarred S. Spencer made a motion to approve the second and final reading of the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget, second by Brenda J. Adair and carried.

B. Second Reading of 2018-2019 Fire Department Budget \$329,655.38

Brenda J. Adair made a motion to approve the second and final reading of the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget for the Cowpens Fire Department, second by Roy Logan and carried.

C. Second Reading – Business License Ordinance

Brenda J. Adair made a motion to approve the second and final reading of an ordinance to update the Business License Ordinance, second by Thomas Voelker and carried. This ordinance changes some of the language referring to revenue and changes the due date of the business license.
