

**TOWN OF COWPENS  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

August 25, 2020**

The Town of Cowpens held a special meeting on Tuesday, August 25 2020, at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Michael D. Hamrick, Council Members Roy Logan, and Thomas Voelker. Absent: Mayor-Tem Brenda J. Adair and Jarred S. Spencer. Mayor Hamrick called the meeting to order

The Town Council met to review budget information for the fiscal year 2019-2020. Teresa Carter presented work sheets for revenue and expenditures and provided budget adjustments for approval by council. In revenue, business license came in at \$53,888.57 over budget while property tax revenue was down by \$34,420.84. Property tax revenue will possibly be collected through delinquent tax payments during this fiscal year. Adjustments were also made for the purchase of the 2020 Ford Explorer for the police department. Expenditures increased due to salaries, retirement, vehicle insurance, tort liability insurance, workers compensation, medical insurance, and new computers for the office and police department. The original budget amount for 2019-2020 was \$1,208,569.00 and the proposed adjusted budget is \$1,242,211.00. Roy Logan made a motion to approve the budget adjustments for 2019-2020, second by Thomas Voelker and carried.

Steve Bolin updated council on the submission of COVID-19 expenses through the SC CARES ACT Program. The town will receive information on this submission throughout the year. Mr. Bolin will keep council updated.

Thomas Voelker made a motion to adjourn, second by Roy Logan and carried.
