

TOWN OF COWPENS  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
December 19, 2016

The Town of Cowpens held its regular council meeting on Monday, December 19, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Michael D. Hamrick, Mayor Pro-Tem Brenda J. Adair, Council Members Roy Logan, Jarred S. Spencer, and Thomas E. Voelker.

Mayor Hamrick called the meeting to order and Jarred S. Spencer held prayer and included a moment of silence for the families of area residents who had lost loved ones and those who have sickness in their families.

**Approval of Agenda**

Jarred S. Spencer made a motion to approve the agenda for December 19, 2016, second by Roy Logan and carried.

**Approval of Minutes**

**Approval of Financial Statements**

**Department Reports**

The Police Department issued 12 citations. There were 7,959 miles accumulated on the police vehicles. Revenue collected was \$860.50 and the town's portion was \$184.35.

Steve Bolin reported the following for the Cowpens Fire Department: Fire Calls in Cowpens-six; Cowpens Fire District- ten; Spartanburg County Mutual Aid - 12; Cherokee County - one. Mr. Bolin also reported that 2,295 miles were accumulated on the fire department vehicles.

**New Business**
